



Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

The REACH Regulation deals, among other things, with the duty of suppliers of products to provide commercial consumers and end consumers with information. Should a product contain a "substance of very high concern" (SVHC), which is listed in the candidate list of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) in a concentration of more than 0.1 wt.-%, sufficient information shall be provided to enable safe use of the product – the minimum requirement is, however, to name the substance. The candidate list, which is updated at regular intervals, can be viewed on the ECHA homepage (<https://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>).

In compliance with article 33 of the REACH regulation, our suppliers are obliged to inform us immediately should a product contain a substance on the candidate list in a concentration of more than 0.1 wt.-%. Furthermore, we have submitted a request to the relevant suppliers to meet this obligation and accordingly to confirm that the products supplied do not contain such substances in an amount exceeding the limit values.

Should a product which you have requested contain a substance on the current candidate list in a concentration greater than 0.1 wt.-%, this can be seen in a separate table.
